This is the SHS graduation class of 1912. Juliet Loutrel says her grandmother, Marjorie Belle Patch, is in the middle row, second from the left, with a large bow in her hair. At that time there were more girls in the graduation class than boys. This may be because the boys were doing one of three things: working on the family farm, apprenticing with a professional person, or going to one of the outlying academies (like Chester or Black River) preparing to go onto college.
